

Discounted Museum Membership and Tickets for Qualifying Families



The *All Play* program provides discounts on tickets and membership to ensure that all families, regardless of income, can play at the museum.

ELIGIBILITY

Any family receiving benefits through EBT, WIC or the National School Lunch Programs is eligible for discounted tickets or membership through the *All Play* program.

ALL PLAY TICKETS

- Qualifying families may purchase admission tickets for \$3 for ages 1 to 101
- Children under age 1 get in free
- Be prepared to show proof of eligibility at the box office

ALL PLAY MEMBERSHIP

Purchase a family membership for \$39

MEMBERSHIP INCLUDES

- Free admission for one year for two adults and all children under age 18 living in a single household
- One additional free guest per visit
- 10% discount at the museum café and store
- Discounts at partner retailers and attractions

- Be prepared to show proof of eligibility at the box office

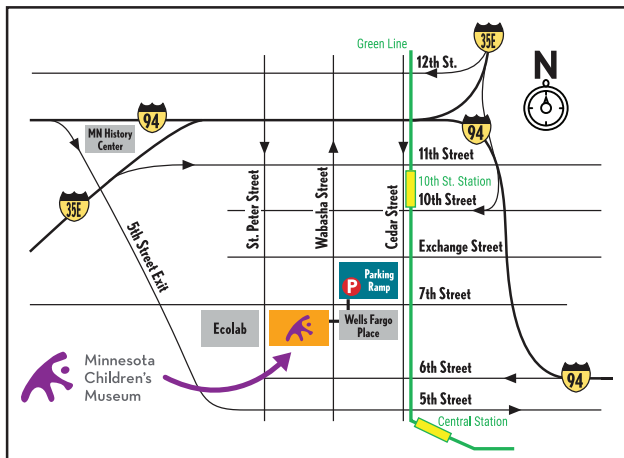

TICKETS

Tickets cost \$16-\$19. Free for children under age 1. Free for members. Visit mcm.org for more information.

PARKING

Parking is available in the World Trade Center parking ramp on Wabasha Street at West Seventh Street. Bring your parking ticket to the museum box office to get a discount on parking (\$7.50 for 3 hours and \$1 for each additional 30 minutes.)



PUBLIC TRANSIT

The museum is located near the 10th Street station on the Metro Transit Green Line. Many buses serve the area. Use the trip planner from Metro Transit to find the most convenient route.

ABOUT THE MUSEUM

- The museum has three floors of exhibits. Kids ages 1 to 10 have fun at the museum.
- The museum has an exhibit made especially for kids ages 3 and under.
- The museum has a cafe with food and drinks for sale.
- There are bathrooms on each floor and special rooms for nursing a baby.
- You can bring a stroller into the museum.
- All children visiting the museum must be accompanied and supervised by an adult 18 years old or older at all times.
- Storage lockers are available near the box office. Lockers require four quarters for each single-time use.
